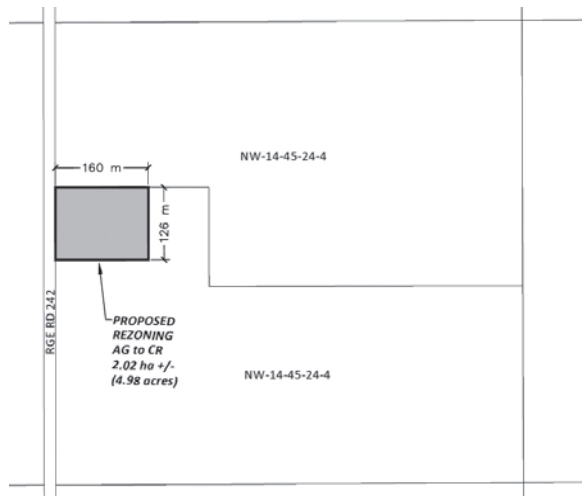

Notice of proposed change in land use classification

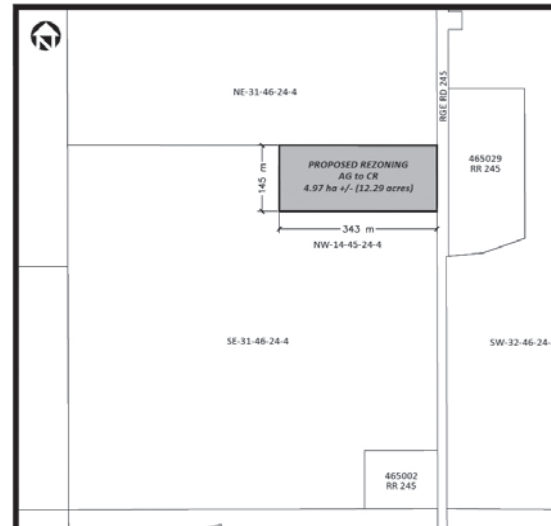

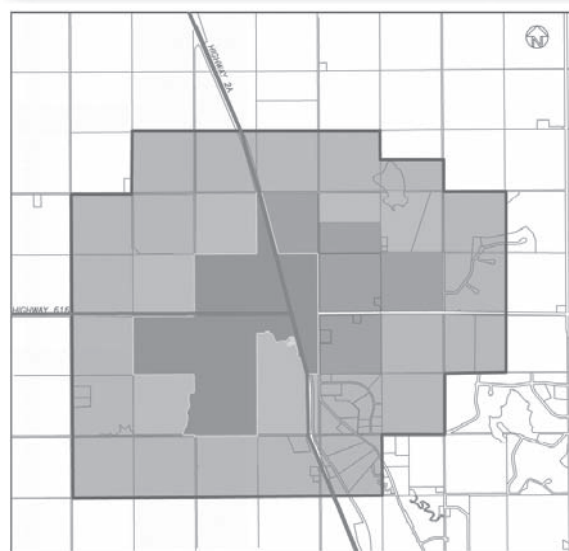
