### 2017 AGRICULTURAL BURSARY APPLICATIONS

An annual Agricultural Bursary in the amount of \$750.00 is made available by the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 to any qualifying applicant who wishes to attend a post-secondary institution in a faculty relating to Agriculture.

The applicant must:

- Be a resident of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 or of a municipality with conterminous boundaries such as the Town of Millet, City of Wetaskiwin or the Summer Villages.
- Be registered in a post-secondary institution in a faculty relating to Agriculture.
- Provide a copy of the letter of acceptance from the post-secondary institution for the current year.
- Provide a letter stating their participation in Agriculture and/or community activities is desirable (participation in agricultural fairs, 4-H memberships, etc.) and stating their goals after obtaining their diploma or degree.

The deadline for applications is October 1, 2017.

#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has prepared a new Land Use Bylaw to replace County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 Land Use Bylaw 1995/54. While retaining many features of the existing Bylaw, this new Bylaw has been designed to include more detail regarding planning, subdivision and development processes and also align with existing County Policies.

A copy of the draft Land Use Bylaw can be obtained from the County Office.

Before proceeding further, Council will hold a Public Hearing at which any person claiming to be affected by the proposed new Land Use Bylaw may ask questions or make their views known. As per the Municipal Government Act, any person affected, has the right to make a presentation.

The hearing will be held in the Council Chambers, County Office, 2.4 kilometres west of Wetaskiwin on Highway 13, at 1:30 p.m., Thursday, October 12, 2017.
