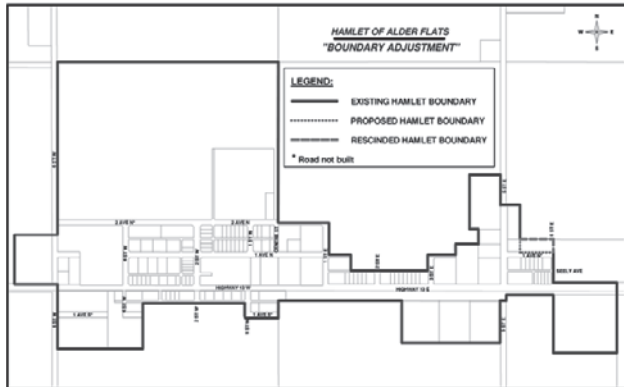

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING



TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 intends to amend its Land Use By-Law with the following boundary adjustments to the Hamlet of Alder Flats, as shown on the accompanying map.
Hamlet of Alder Flats

As the County has been in the process of reviewing all Hamlet boundaries and civic

addressing, the County's intent is to ensure all properties within the Hamlet comply with the County's current Land Use By-Law.

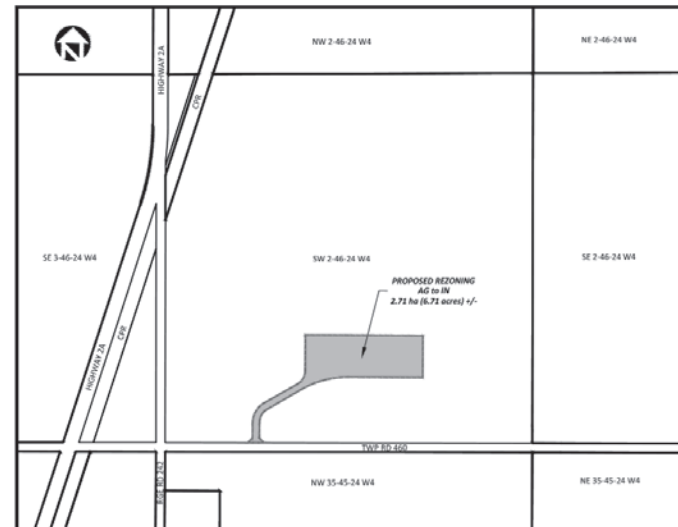

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice of proposed change in land use classification

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has received an application to amend its Land Use By-Law by rezoning part of the following land, as shown on accompanying map, from **Agricultural (AG)** to **Industrial (IN)**:



SW 2-46-24-W4M

If the rezoning is approved, the applicant intends to develop a proposed grain handling complex as outlined in the G3 Canada Ltd.

Area Structure Plan. A copy of the Industrial District outlining permitted and discretionary uses can be obtained from the County Office.
