

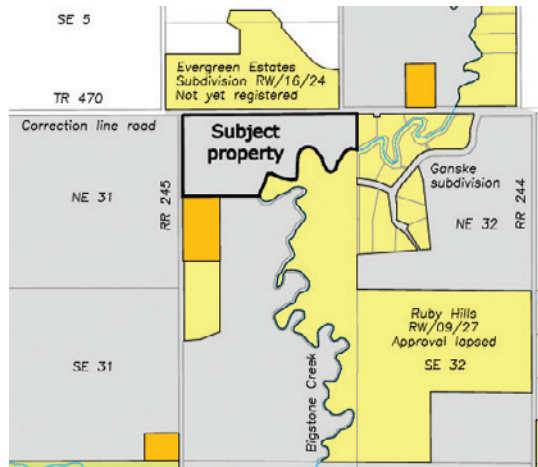

INTERESTED IN BECOMING A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER?

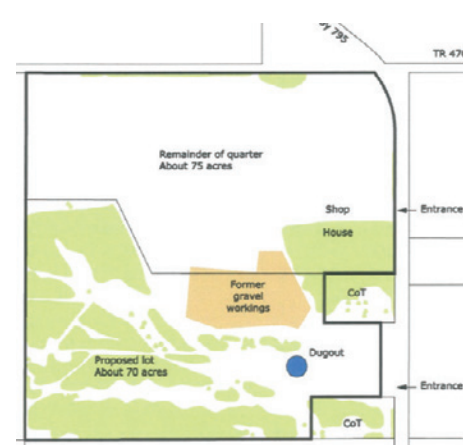
