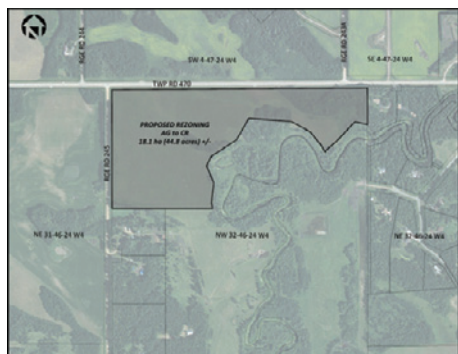
RE: PROPERTY TAXES

Tax payment deadline is August 31st, 2018. To avoid penalty charges applied September 1st, 2018, property tax payments made by mail should be CLEARLY POSTMARKED no later than August 31st, 2018, or you can drop off your payments at the County of Wetaskiwin Administration Office (mail slot in front door) prior to September 1st, 2018. The County office is located 1 ½ mile west on Hwy 13 from Hwy 2A.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has received an application to amend its Land Use By-Law by rezoning part of the following land, as shown on accompanying map, from **Agricultural (AG)** to **Country Residential (CR)**:
