## RENTAL EQUIPMENT

The following items are available for rent from the County of Wetaskiwin:

- Skunk traps (several)
- Magpie Traps (several)
- Estate Sprayers (2) – for lawn spraying.
- Pasture Sprayers (3) – two new sprayers were built in 2015. These sprayers are intended for range & pasture product applications only. They will cover 20 acres @ 200 L/Ha (20 gal/acre) spray volume using two boomless nozzles.
- Tree Insect (Bug) Sprayer – intended only for spraying insecticides on trees. Equipped with a handgun and high pressure pump to spray up into the tree canopy.
- Tree Seedling Planter – for planting seedling trees.
- Plastic Mulch Applicator – in cooperation with and available through Leduc County, pickup can be arranged at the County Office in Wetaskiwin.
- Scare Cannons (4) – producer to provide propane.

Note: Equipment is only available at the County Office in Wetaskiwin, and is no longer available in Winfield. Any items not appearing on this list have been disposed of and will not be replaced.
