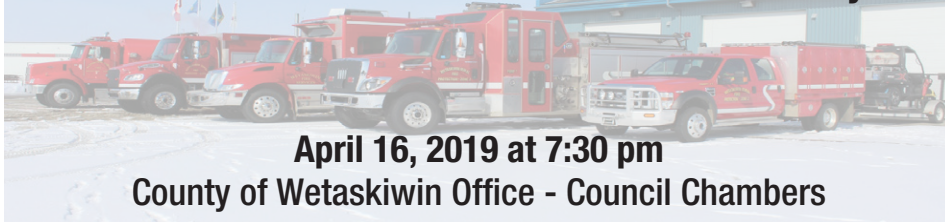

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS:

- Shoulder Pull/Ditching; 6 Miles on TWP 450 between RGE RD 243 and HWY 822
- Replace Guard Rail & other work on TWP 462 between RGE RD 224.5 and RGE RD 225.25
- Clay Cap & Shoulder Pull; 2.75 Miles on TWP 472 between HWY 2A and RGE RD 250

OILING PROJECTS:

- Spot repairs in Springtree Park
- Paving and Guardrail on TWP 455 and HWY 2 Flyover
- Double Chip Seal 1 Mile on TWP 464 between RGE RD 244 and RGE RD 245
