The County of Wetaskiwin is seeking a motorgrader operator for the Lakedell area in the County of Wetaskiwin. The motorgrader will be housed at the Lakedell Transfer Station site. The successful candidate will report to the West End Foreman and will be responsible for grading, snowplowing and generally maintaining gravel surface local roads and other duties as required within approximately 100 mile grader beat in Division 6.
