FIRE GUARDIANS - 2015

Fire Permits are **REQUIRED** from **April 1st to October 31st** and may be obtained from the Fire Guardian in your area. (Clip this list out and keep it handy for reference).

An application for a Fire Permit should be made two or three days prior to the first day of burning. A Permit will be issued for a maximum ten-day period beginning from the date of issue; however certain conditions may be required in order for a permit to be issued. If an extended period is required for burning, application must be made for another Fire Permit after the first Permit is terminated.

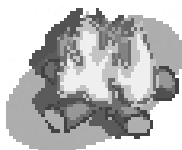

PERMISSION TO BURN STUBBLE:

Under the Soil Conservation Act the County of Wetaskiwin has the authority to issue Stubble Burning Permits. These permits are issued on an individual basis and a site inspection must be performed.

Director of Agricultural Services, Stephan Majek, is the only one with the authority in the County of Wetaskiwin to issue Stubble Burning Permits, please contact him at 780-361-6226.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS A HOLDER OF A FIRE PERMIT:

1. Fire Permit gives authority to the permittee to set a fire according to the regulations and the terms and conditions printed on the Permit. Conditions stated on your fire permit must be strictly adhered to. You may be liable for fire suppression costs or penalties as provided by law for any damage that may occur while burning without a permit, or for failing to comply with the conditions as stated on your fire permit.
2. A Fire Permit **DOES NOT** relieve the holder from the responsibility of keeping that fire under control and extinguishing, if necessary.
