2015 AGRICULTURAL BURSARY APPLICATIONS

An annual Agricultural Bursary in the amount of \$500.00 is made available by the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 to any qualifying applicant who wishes to attend a post-secondary institution in a faculty relating to Agriculture.

The applicant must:

- Be a resident of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 or of a municipality with conterminous boundaries such as the Town of Millet, City of Wetaskiwin or the Summer Villages.

- Provide a copy of the letter of acceptance from the post-secondary institution for the current year.
