#### Required Skills:

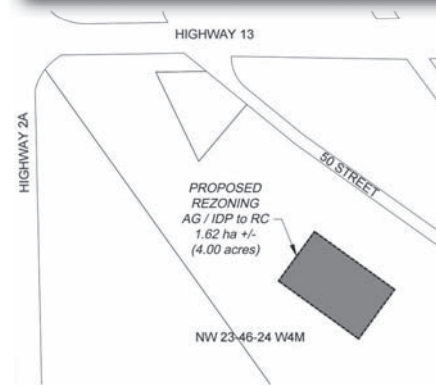
The successful candidate:

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING



#### Notice of proposed change in land use classification

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has received an application to amend its Land Use By-Law by rezoning 4.0 acres of the following land, as shown on accompanying map, from **Agricultural/Intermunicipal Development Plan (AID) to Rural Commercial (RC)**:

#### **NW 23-46-24-W4M**

If the rezoning is approved, the applicant intends to use the 4.0 acres of land for recreational vehicle and boat storage. A copy of the Rural Commercial

District outlining permitted and discretionary uses can be obtained from the County Office. Before proceeding further with the proposal, Council will hold a Public Hearing at which any person claiming to be affected by the proposed rezoning may ask questions or make their views known.

The hearing will be held in the Council Chambers, County Office, 2.4 kilometres west of Wetaskiwin on Highway 13, at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, November 10, 2016.

Written submissions will be accepted up to the time of the hearing and should be addressed to the undersigned at the County Office.
