Consider how your life would change if you lost your water supply!

Did you know that a poorly maintained water well can put your water supply at risk of contamination and reduce your well yield?

If you are one of 450,000 Albertans who use their water well for household purposes, the key to ensuring your water supply is safe and secure is knowing how groundwater works, learning about your well and understanding how to properly maintain it.

Proper water well siting, construction, maintenance and plugging will help protect your well from biofouling and contamination, save you costly repairs, and ensure your well water yields are sustained over many years.

Find out what you can do to protect your well. Attend the **FREE water well management workshop** being hosted by **County of Wetaskiwin** and presented by the **Working Well Program**, with technical expertise provided by **Alberta Agriculture** and **Rural Development and Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development**.

During the workshop we will cover:

- Groundwater – how it works
- Water quality and quantity testing
- Well protection – protecting your well from contamination
- Basic well maintenance
- Water sampling – how to do it

To attend the workshop, please **pre-register** by calling Heather at the County of Wetaskiwin Office. We will require your legal land description in order to retrieve your water well report from the Alberta Water Wells Groundwater information site.

SNOWPLOWING PROGRAM

The County of Wetaskiwin is offering residents the option to purchase prepaid snowplowing flag exclusively for plowing of private driveways from the County roadway to allow the ratepayer access to their place of residence.

These flags may be purchased at the County Office or other locations designated by the County administration at a cost of \$50.00 per flag, including GST, which is valid for one use only.

The flag must be posted at the driveway indicating a request for snowplowing. The flag will be collected by the Patrol Operator when the driveway is plowed. Residents who reside within a Hamlet, within the corporate municipal boundaries of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 are not included in this policy.

NOTE: Snowplowing of driveways will only take place when all County roads have been plowed first.
