The County of Wetaskiwin is seeking to fill the position of a Nine (9) month seasonal Light Equipment Operator/Sprayer Operator. Reporting to the Agricultural Services Foreman, the successful candidate will be responsible for operating the County's spray truck, light duty equipment such as tractor, or skid steer, performing minor equipment repairs and ongoing regular maintenance of equipment including shop maintenance. This is a nine (9) month seasonal position working 40 hour per week; anticipated start date March 1, 2020 with end date of November 30, 2020.
