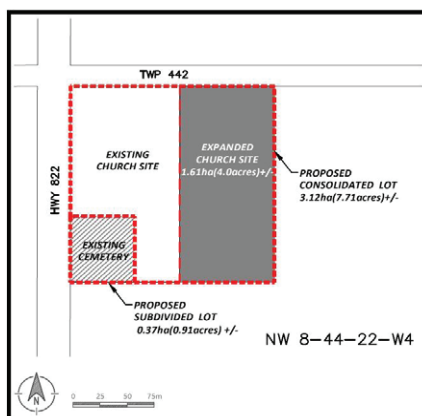

The Position: The County of Wetaskiwin is seeking a seasonal temporary position of Beaver Trapper. This position works up to 40 hours per week Monday to Friday, from Spring break-up (April 15) to approximately November 15, 2020.

Reporting to the Director of Agricultural Services, you will be responsible for the safe and efficient removal of beaver and beaver dams on County land, Crown land and occasionally private land. This will include setting beaver traps, trapping beavers, breaching of beaver dams through blasting and removal of debris.

- The ability to work alone with flexible hours
- Resident Trapper
- Registered Trapper with Fish and Wildlife
- Must have the ability to obtain an Explosives Permit for Beaver Dam
