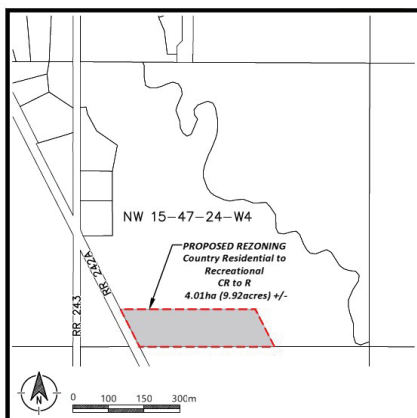

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice of proposed change in land use classification

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has received an application to amend its Land Use By-Law by rezoning part of the following land within **NW-15-47-24-W4 Lot 2, Plan 9523943**, as shown on accompanying map, from **Country Residential District (CR)** to **Recreational District (R)**:



If the rezoning is approved, the applicant intends to achieve compliance for the existing campground. A copy of the **Recreational District** outlining permitted and discretionary uses can be obtained from the County's Administration Building or by emailing [wpermits@county10.ca](mailto:wpermits@county10.ca). Before proceeding further with the proposal, Council will hold a Public Hearing at which any person claiming to be affected by the proposed rezoning may ask questions or make their views known. As per the Municipal Government Act, any person affected, has the right to petition this proposal.

**The hearing will be held in the Council Chambers at the County's Administration Building, 2.4 kilometres west of Wetaskiwin on Highway 13, at 10:15 a.m., Thursday, April 09, 2020.**

Written submissions will be accepted up to the time of the hearing and should be addressed to the undersigned at the County's Administration Building.

## COUNTY OF WETASKIWIN

*FIRE GUARDIANS – 2020*

Fire Permits are **REQUIRED** from **March 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>** and may be obtained from the Fire Guardian in your area.

An application for a Fire Permit should be made two or three days prior to the first day of burning. A Permit will be issued for a maximum ten-day period beginning from the date of issue; however certain conditions may be required in order for a permit to be issued. If an extended period is required for burning, application must be made for another Fire Permit after the first Permit is terminated.

### **PERMISSION TO BURN STUBBLE:**

Under the Soil Conservation Act the County of Wetaskiwin has the authority to issue Stubble Burning Permits. These permits are issued on an individual basis and a site inspection must be performed.

### **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS A HOLDER OF A FIRE PERMIT:**

1. A Fire Permit gives authority to the permittee to set a fire according to the regulations and the terms and conditions printed on the Permit. Conditions stated on your fire permit must be strictly adhered to. You may be liable for fire suppression costs or penalties as provided by law for any damage that may occur while burning without a permit, or for failing to comply with the conditions as stated on your fire permit.
2. A Fire Permit **DOES NOT** relieve the holder from the responsibility of keeping that fire under control and extinguishing, if necessary.
