RENTAL EQUIPMENT

The following items are available for rent from the County of Wetaskiwin:

- Skunk traps (several)
- Magpie Traps (several)
- Estate Sprayers (2) – for lawn spraying.
- Pasture Sprayers (3) – two new sprayers built in 2015. These sprayers are intended for range & pasture product applications only. They cover 20 acres @ 200 L/Ha (20 gal/acre) spray volume using two boomless nozzles.
- Tree Insect (Bug) Sprayer – intended only for spraying insecticide on trees. Equipped with a handgun and high pressure pump to spray up into the tree canopy.
- Tree Seedling Planter – for planting seedling trees.
- Plastic Mulch Applicator – in cooperation with and available through Leduc County, pickup can be arranged at the County Office in Wetaskiwin.
- Scare Cannons (4) – producer to provide propane.

Note: Equipment is only available at the County Office in Wetaskiwin, and is no longer available in Winfield.
