Any resident wishing to have an application of dust control must submit a completed application and payment to the County of Wetaskiwin Administration office no later than June 1. Late applications may not be considered.

Fees shall be \$6.50 per lineal metre (plus GST).

Dust control services shall only be offered during the period of June 1 to September 1 of each calendar year.
