### Public Works Shop Hand • Posting #2021/15

#### The Position:

The County of Wetaskiwin is seeking a permanent full time Shop Hand based out of the Wetaskiwin Shop. Reporting to the Fleet Services Foreman, the successful candidate will be responsible for assisting the Automotive and Heavy-Duty Mechanics in their daily work along with general shop and yard work. Duties include the use and care of shop equipment and tools, welding and general metalwork, management of parts and inventory, parts delivery and pick-up, and pressure washing of fleet vehicles. Regular hours of work are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

#### Required Skills:

The successful candidate will possess:

- A Class 5 Driver's license; having air endorsement, Class 3 or Class 1 is preferred;
- Good physical condition as the work is physical in nature and on occasion, heavy lifting is required as part of regular duty;
- Metalwork repairs; cutting, welding, grinding and assembly;
- A self-starter with the ability to work independently and without constant supervision;
- A team player, able to work in a fast-paced team environment and work well with other shop personnel.
