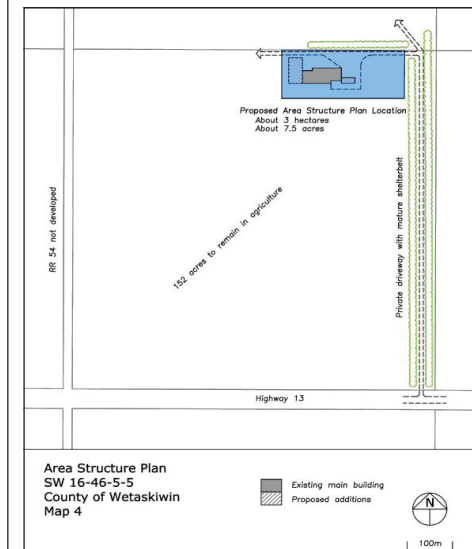

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has been asked to adopt an Area Structure Plan within **SW-16-46-5-W5M**, for the intent to rezone a 3 hectares (7.5 acres) to Industrial for a welding/fabrication shop on the following land which is located along Highway 13, as shown on the accompanying map.



Before considering the adoption of the Area Structure Plan, Council will hold a public hearing at which any person claiming to be affected by the proposed Area Structure Plan may ask questions or make their views known.

The hearing will be held in the Council Chambers of the County of Wetaskiwin

Administration Building located 2.4 kilometres west of Wetaskiwin on Highway 13, at 10:15 a.m. on Thursday, June 10, 2021.

In accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, members of the public still have the right to attend these meetings in person along with virtually. However, Administration and Council are **strongly encouraging and recommending** that communication be through alternative methods such as email, mailed correspondence, fax, or otherwise, rather than public attending the meeting in person. This will ensure that the information is presented to Council at or before the meeting and will also ensure the health and safety of all members of the public and County Staff.
